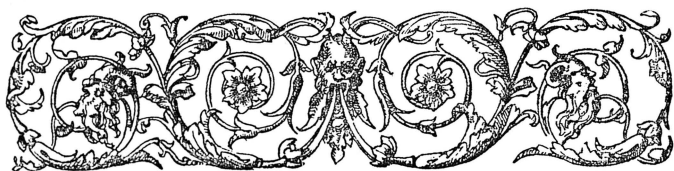

Preface.

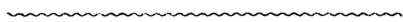
In the Autumn of 1887 it occurred to some Antiquaries, resident in the Counties of Somerset and Dorset, that the time was come for the establishment of a local "*Notes and Queries*" for circulation in the district.
